

How to make a box for your Stories for My Little Sister playing cards

- 1. First, if you haven't got your playing cards yet, you can download instructions on how to make them at:



- 3. Next, use a pair of craft scissors to carefully cut along the outline of the box.
- 4. Now fold along the black lines. Make sure that the sides of the card with the pictures are on the outside of the box.
- 5. Finally, apply glue along the yellow panels and seal them to the inner sides of the box.

Now you have a neat box where you can store your **Stories for My Little Sister** playing cards!
