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How to make your very own Stories for My Little Sister playing cards

1. Start by printing out the following file:

https://www.storiesformylittlesister.com/extras/card-games/playing-cards.pdf
It's best if you can print it out in colour on light card.

It will look like this:



In the file there are eight families of cards, with four cards per family. The families are:

- Annabella (aardvark);
- Corduroy and Velvet (hedgehogs);
- · Moochie (turtle);
- Pink Ethel (elephant);
- Squeaks, Megan and Cornelia (mice);
- Stinky and Big Pong (skunks);
- Tuppence and her parents (penguins);
- Watson and Cricket (lorikeets [that's the type of bird they are!]).



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2. Next, you'll need to cut along the black lines to separate the cards.



Now you have your very own Stories for My Little Sister cards!

There are lots of games you can play with your cards.

A couple of our favourites are the Memory Game and Happy Families.
